Floral aromas with notes of almond and ripe peach and aromatic fruits flavours.

Citrus aromas and mineral overtones, balanced by zesty freshness and a long, lingering mineral finish.

Rich, ripe fruit flavours mingle with creamy brioche in this beautiful Tuscan example of Chardonnay.
